Directions

From the Pasadena area: Take the 210 (Foothill Fwy) east; exit at #45/CA-57 S/ Santa Ana onto Orange Fwy (CA-57 S). Go 14.9 mi.

Take the I-10/San Bernardino/LA exit onto San Bernardino Fwy East (I-10 E). Exit at Haven Ave. Turn right. At Guasti Road, turn left; go one block to hotel.

From the Corona area: Take the Riverside Fwy (CA-91 E) to the I-15/Barstow/San Diego exit onto Corona Fwy (I-15 N) toward Barstow. Go 2.2 mi. Take the I-10/Los Angeles/SB exit onto San Bernardino Fwy (I-10 W) toward L.A. Go 0.3 mi; exit at #56/Haven Ave. Turn left onto N. Haven Ave. At Guasti Road, turn left; go one block to hotel.
